Credit Card Theft and Drug Arrests-

At approximately 1620 hours, Ashland police responded to a suspicious situation at the Bank of America, in the 400 block of England Street in Ashland. Ashland police apprehended three adults and one juvenile, all from Florida, as they attempted to leave the bank. All suspects were charged with credit card theft and possession of narcotics. The suspects were incarcerated at Paumonkey Regional Jail and held without bond. All arrested persons are suspects in other crimes at Bank of America's in surrounding Metro Richmond jurisdictions.
