The Ashland Police Department is requesting the community's assistance in identifying the suspect from a robbery, which occurred at the Hampton Inn hotel located in the 700 block of England Street.

At 10:45 pm, an unknown male subject entered the lobby of the Hampton Inn hotel and held a brief conversation with the clerk and then left. Several minutes later, the suspect returned to the lobby of the hotel and demanded money from the clerk. The subject kept his hand in his jacket pocket and acted as if he had a handgun. The suspect removed money from the clerk's register, told the clerk to lie down on the ground and left the hotel without any further incident. The suspect fled in an unknown direction with an undisclosed amount of money. The suspect is described as a white male, medium to heavy built, 5'10" to 6'2. He appeared unshaven and was possibly between the ages of 25 to 35. The suspect was wearing a red, yellow and black jacket with a front zipper and a hood.
