The Ashland Police Department Celebrates “National Seat Check Saturday” on September 12th

The Ashland Police Department is celebrating “National Seat Check Saturday” by inviting the community to a free child safety seat installation event in the Ashland/Hanover Shopping Center located at the intersection of North Washington Highway and England Street in Ashland. The Ashland Police Department will have certified technicians available to provide on-site child safety seat inspections and education on Saturday, September 12th from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm. “It’s the responsibility of every parent and caregiver out there to make sure their children are safely restrained – every trip, every time,” said Chief Doug Goodman. “We are urging everyone to get their child safety seats inspected. When it comes to the safety of a child, there is no room for mistakes.”

National Child Passenger Safety Week (September 12-18) is an annual campaign to bring public attention to the importance of properly securing all children in appropriate child safety seats, booster seats, or seat belts – every trip, every time. The campaign kicks off on September 12, 2009, with “National Seat Check Saturday,” where certified child passenger safety technicians provide free child safety seat inspections nationwide that educate parents and caregivers on how to install their child’s safety seats properly in their vehicles.
