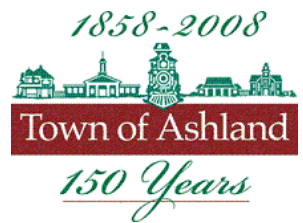

**The Ashland Police Department is requesting the community's assistance in identifying the suspect from a robbery, which occurred at the Travel Centers of America located in the 100 block of North Carter Road off of England Street.**

At 7:00am, an unknown male subject entered the fuel desk area of the business, displayed a silver and black handgun at the clerks and demanded money. He fled in an unknown direction with an undisclosed amount of money. The suspect is described as a black male, thin to medium build, possibly 155 –165 lbs, 5'7" to 5'9". He appeared to have a thin mustache and was possibly between the ages of 20 – 30. The suspect was wearing a gold; Roca Wear knit cap and a black leather jacket.
