Please be aware that this Sunday, November 21, 2010, at 2:30 pm, the Ashland Holiday Parade will be taking place. Henry Street from England Street to Archie Cannon Drive will be closed as well as Thompson Street from Medical Drive to Henry Street. There will be "No Parking" on the parade route from 6:00 am until 5:00 pm that day, as well as "No Parking" on South Snead Street after 10:00 am.

Ashland Public works will begin leaf removal at 6:00 am Sunday morning on Henry Street. They would respectfully ask that all parked vehicles be moved off Henry Street by 11:30 pm Saturday, November 20, 2010, Duncan Memorial Church patron's vehicles please be moved by 12:00 noon. All parking lots will remain open, however vehicles will be prohibited from travelling on Henry Street until approximately 5:00 pm. Vehicles exiting the Randolph-Macon College campus during this time must do so via North Center Street to North James Street from the west side, or via Calhoun St. (behind Copley Science Building) to Caroline Street from the east side.

***Towing will begin promptly at 10:00 am Sunday and be strictly enforced by the Town of Ashland Police Department.***
