Ashland Police Department and Hanover County Sheriff's Office make arrests on four robbery suspects.

The Ashland Police Department has obtained charges for four subjects involved in an armed robbery in the 100 block of North Carter Road in Ashland. At approximately 1130 pm, a male subject was approached by these four individuals in a parking lot. One of the subjects pointed a handgun at the man and demanded money from him. The 39 year old victim attempted to flee but was struck from the rear by one of these suspects sustaining minor injuries. The suspects all fled in a vehicle and were located shortly afterwards by Hanover County Sheriff's Deputies just off of the Doswell exit of interstate 95.

Three of the suspects were adults and were charged with armed robbery and incarcerated at Pamunkey Regional Jail. The one juvenile was charged with aggravated battery and armed robbery and was incarcerated at a juvenile facility.

"This is a prime example of the teamwork that exists in law enforcement on a daily basis," said Chief Doug Goodman. "The rapid response by officers and dissemination of information helped to capture the suspects and solve this unfortunate crime."
