Ashland Police arrest suspect involved in commercial business grand larcenies.

On August 1, 2011, several commercial businesses reported to the Ashland Police Department that several heavy duty air conditioning units had been vandalized and/or stolen from the roof of the Ashland Junction Shopping Center. These air units were valued at approximately \$36,000.00. Based on intelligent information gathered by alert Ashland patrol officers on the night of the crime, surveillance was placed on suspects almost immediately. In the early morning hours of August 5, 2011, the suspect was observed committing another larceny at a business located in Ashland. He was taken into custody by investigators and patrol officers at that point.

The suspect, 18 year-old Travis Cawthorn of the 6000 block of Mechanicsville Turnpike, was charged with 2 counts of Grand Larceny. He was incarcerated at Pamunkey Regional Jail on a \$1500 bond.
