Arrests Made in Recent Home Burglaries

The Ashland Police Department working in conjunction with the Hanover County Sheriff's Office have arrested three individuals in connection to a series of recent residential break-ins in the Town of Ashland and Hanover County. Charles Hogge, a 23-year-old male of the 300 block of North Snead Street in Ashland, Ashley Rasnake, a 21-year old female of the 15000 block of Melody Hills Drive in Hanover and Stewart Curtis Baker, a 32-year old male from the 200 block of North Snead Street in Ashland were all arrested on twenty-three felony charges, to include breaking and entering and grand larceny.

These individuals have been linked to several daytime residential break-ins in the Ashland and surrounding Hanover County areas. All of the incidents have occurred between March and April of this year.

Investigators from both agencies continue to explore additional leads and share information to determine if these individuals have been responsible for any other crimes in the area.

The cooperation and excellent partnership between the Ashland Police Department and the Hanover County Sheriff's Office was a major determining factor in identifying the individuals responsible for these crimes and quickly taking them in to custody.
